
BLUEBERRY PERPETUA



- RIPENING TIME: MIDSEASON (JULY) & LATE SEASON (SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER)...YEAH YOU READ THAT RIGHT, THIS VARIETY IS THE FIRST BLUEBERRY TO GIVE YOU TWO HARVESTS IN ONE YEAR!
- SIZE OF BERRY: SMALL EARLY CROP & LARGE LATER CROP
- FLAVOR: SWEET
- USES: GREAT FOR FRESH EATING, FREEZING & BAKING
- PLANT SIZE: 3-4 FT TALL
- **GROWING:** ALL BLUEBERRIES LIKE FULL SUN AND ACIDIC SOIL. THEY ARE SELF POLLINATING BUT WILL PRODUCE SIGNIFICANTLY MORE & LARGER FRUIT IF PLANTED NEAR ANOTHER VARIETY THAT RIPENS AT THE SAME TIME. THEY ARE SLOW GROWING AND NEED ABOUT 5 YEARS BEFORE PRODUCING A LOT OF BERRIES. PRUNE OUT DEAD, OLD BRANCHES IN WINTER.
- OTHER: ATTRACTIVE AS AN ORNAMENTAL, GROWS INTO A VASE SHAPE
